Progress

What progresses was reported by the AT members during the meeting?

12. 01. 2021.

AT meeting in the Community Centre,

Participated Agnus Dei Üprus, Fea Üprus, Avo Üprus, Aarne Lätte, Risto Abel,

The meeting was a preparation for the SEMPRE Acc web meeting, January 21.

Discussions were on the subjects the regional/local seminar and the social entrepreneurship ecosystem. The AT and MP members discussed who should be involved and how to document the AL event. It was decided to organise a workshop — if possible, as a physical meeting, in case of severe restrictions via Zoom. It was decided to invite to participate representatives of the Parish, schools, kindergarten, and prisons, also the parents of the children with severe disabilities as end-users.

The problem to be analysed was the activities in the context of inclusive entrepreneurship. What have been the main achievements or what should be done differently? Using there appreciative inquiry method. Also the communicative aspects – to whom and how pass the knowledge about the activities of the Centre. It was decided to compare the present sitiation with the research done 2 years ago, and also the interviews performed by a Finnish partner Ulla Siirto.

Secondly, it was decided to make videoclips about main activities of the Centre – support services to ex-offenders, children with severe disabilities, reading and tea room, drama studio, flamenco dancing, shin-do, cooking class and bread baking, carpentry studio, guest rooms. Agnus Dei is responsible for selection of the material, videos are made by Urmas Roos.It is also important to reflect the story of Aino Järvesoo, who donated the Church to the community. Aino expected it to be a Lutheran church for families and childres, with an active congregation. SEPRE and SEMPRE ACC have been very strong support in fulfilling these wishes.

16.01.21. Sub-AT meeting – ex-offenders

End-user, an ex-offender Sergei Maškov, supported by the Unemployment Fund, organized computer consultations for the employees of the Community Center, entering Russian text into the materials. Data processing (Excel). This was done as a result of the MP end-users request.

27.01 SUB-AT meeting – support for ex-offenders -

So called Backpack project:





The project implementation has been discussed in collaboration with the Ministry of Justice, representatives of prisons and the Baltic Institute for Crime Prevention (leads the project). Action learning was used to monitor, record and evaluate the process, using AL and appreciative inquiry metods. Basic idea was that quite often the detainee leaves the prison, his/her belongings in a black trash bag. First of all, it is unworthy and very uncomfortable. As a solution, the Institute bought 100 backpacks for to those released from prison, bags contain also personal consumables and a notebook with the addresses of the possible assisting organizations. These bags are stored in prisons and when detainee is released, the bag is given to him/her. As the results of the discussions it was pointed out that the cooperation with Tallinn prison goes smoothly, with Tartu prison additional work is needed. As due to COVID-19 prisons are closed to all visitors, direct meetings with the prison workers are limited, the only solution is to work with contact persons.

29.01 Readers club has got into the wings of the wind.

Readres club was organised at the request of the book lenders and became popular at once.

Contact free book lending itself has increased greatly, especially by school children. An extremly interesting event took place: "to review a book that I have not read".

30.01 The Day of Beauty

It has become a great favourite of the local ladies and takes place once a month. It serves several aims: bring more people to the Centre, increase the number of services, and to get rent for premises.
